TRIAL MEMBERSHIP

Set on the scenic Snowdonia coastline in the historic castle town of Harlech, Royal St David's Golf Club is quite simply one of the finest traditional links courses in the world which, through its 123 years has played host to more than 50 major championships. In 2009 the Club hosted the Ladies' British Open Amateur Championship and the S4C Wales Ladies Championship of Europe. In 2011 the Club hosted the Boys Home Internationals, in 2013 the Jacques Leglisé Trophy, in 2019 (the Club's 125th Year) the R&A Womens Senior Amateur Championship and in 2020, the Womens and Girls Home International Matches.

As befits its Royal, National and International standing, Royal St David's history is one of evolution rather than revolution. Whilst the Club maintains a strong membership, offering home, away and international categories, it is mindful of today's financial climate and has therefore introduced a **Trial Membership**. The cost of this membership category is £268.00 + Wales Golf Affiliation Fee (currently £14.20) and will be made up of playing credits and House membership. A round of golf will be charged at rates between 12 - 20 credits, dependant on the time of day and season of the year. You will be able to top-up your credits in multiples of £50 if you so wish.

This alternative membership will be made available only to **new member applications**, subject to the Club's usual ratification process, and is limited to a **maximum of two years**. Having been a Trial Member for two years you will be invited to become a full member.

Whilst there are numerous reasons for this new membership scheme it should not be overlooked that Royal St David's home and away memberships offer excellent value for money at £721 and £489 respectively for the year.

The following conditions will apply to Trial Members:

1. The scheme is open to new members or to those whose membership has lapsed by more than two years and will be classed as Category C members and will be entitled to all the benefits of Category A and B members except for the following:
2. After the 2-year period, the member shall decide whether he/she wishes to become a full member of the Club. Any outstanding credits will not be repaid at the end of the trial period if the scheme is discontinued and the person will cease to be a member of the Club. Neither will any credits be repaid if the member decides to resign within any year's membership period.
3. Category C members have no voting rights.
4. Credits may be topped up at any time in multiples of £50.
5. Trial members may convert to Category A or B membership at any time during the trial period and may use any outstanding credits towards the cost of doing so.
6. They are eligible to enter all club competitions, at 20 credits per event, except for 'Board' competitions.
7. Competition entry fees, which are in addition to the above, will be at members' rates.
8. Guest rates are not applicable to Category C members.
9. Carry-over of credits from year to year will be allowed.
10. Membership and credits are non-transferrable.
11. Subscriptions will be renewable on the 1st of April each year, regardless of the amount of credits in balance.
12. Booking of tee times must be made through the Pro Shop or on the Club's on-line booking system.
13. Any person found abusing the system will be suspended immediately and following an investigation into the circumstances this may result in expulsion from the Club.
