

Please Note:

1. Men's Competitions 2019

- Entries to all the Men's competitions contained in this book will be open to
 players with Competition Handicaps only, unless otherwise stated. <u>Those</u>
 without Competition Handicaps are encouraged to play in at least three
 qualifying competitions during the year in order to gain a Competitive
 status See item 5 below.
- Unless otherwise stated, the maximum handicap for all competitions will be 54. Board Competitions will maintain the handicap limit of 28. These competitions will be identified with a (BC) on the entry form.
- Handicap Limit This means that a player with a higher handicap is not eligible to enter e.g. Harlech Town Bowl, where the Handicap Limit is 28. (see also General Competition Conditions)
- Players are not allowed to choose with whom they play in competitions.
- The tee used for each competition will be specified either by the entry book or on the day of the competition by the Committee or Pro Shop.

2. <u>Ladies' Competitions 2019</u>

- Entries to all the Ladies' competitions contained in this book will be open to players with Competition Handicaps only. See also item 5 below.
- Unless otherwise stated, the maximum handicap for all competitions will be 54. Board Competitions will maintain the handicap limit of 36 (Except the Challenge Bowl – 24). These competitions will be identified with a (BC) on the entry form. An additional competition will be run in conjunction with the board events for those with handicaps of 37+.
- Players are not allowed to choose with whom they play in competitions.
- All ladies' competitions will be played from the red tees, unless otherwise stated.

3. Junior Boys & Girls

- For competition purposes, Junior members are those aged under 18 on the day of the competition.
- Juniors with CONGU handicaps are permitted to enter all competitions, except where limits prevent entry.

4. <u>Mixed Open Weekend, Open Festival, Open Weekend</u> & Other Open Competitions

The **Open Festival** will be held between Thursday 18th of July and Sunday 21st of July. The **Open Weekend** will be held on Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th of September. The events, which are open to members and visitors will include:

• 18th July - Texas Scramble, Team of 4*

19th July - Betterball Stableford*

• 20th July - Duke of York (Texas Scramble, Team of 4*)

21st July - Morfa & Patterson Cups
 7th September - Texas Scramble, Team of 4*

8th September - Betterball Stableford*

*Denotes that the competition is open to any combination of men, ladies and juniors (mixed).

• 18th April – 23rd April - Easter Meeting

• 25th June - Senior Men's Open (55+)

• 10th – 14th August - Ladies Open Summer Meeting

• 24th September - Senior Men's Open (55+)

• 1st – 2nd October - Seniors' Silver Cross (Scratch S/ford)

5. **Supplementary Scores**

- Members can help to <u>maintain</u> their Competition Handicap status by submitting 'Supplementary Scores' (with the exception of Category 1 players).
- Supplementary Scores may be returned at all GB&I clubs of which a player is a member. The card must be signed by the playing partner and comply with the Rules of Golf.
- Players in Handicap Categories 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 are eligible to submit an **unlimited** number of Supplementary Scores per year.
- Category 1 players must comply with CONGU rules on supplementary scores. Please see CONGU website for guidance.

TERMS OF COMPETITION

Competitions shall be open to players who are members of an Affiliated golf club; who have Amateur Status
in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of the R & A Rules Limited and who hold a current
CONGU (not suspended) Handicap.

ENTRIES

- Entries close at noon on the date stated on the Entry Form. Late entries may be placed on a reserve list and if
 accepted will start at the end of the field. No late entries will be accepted for the Winchilsea Foursomes,
 Harlech Town Bowl & Ladies' Challenge Bowl.
- The appropriate entry fee must accompany the completed entry form.
 Entry fees will not be refunded unless notice of withdrawal in writing is received before the closing date for entries. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that his/her entry has been received.
- 3. No member whose subscription remains unpaid at 31st March may enter any Club Competition
- 4. Entry forms can be downloaded from the Competitions page of the Club website.

ENTRY FEES

- 1. Visitors/Guests:
 - a. Open Mixed Foursomes £20 per player
 - b. St David's Gold Cross & Seniors' Silver Cross £50 (Members £25)
- 2. Members: (£1 surcharge for late entry)
 - a. Winchilsea Foursomes £6 per player
 - b. Club Championship, Harlech Town Bowl and Edward VII £6 per player
 - c. All other competitions, unless otherwise stated £5 per player.
 - Entries will not be accepted without payment. Cheques should be made payable to Royal St.David's Golf Club.
 - e. Entries on the day of competition will only be accepted if there are empty slots available.
 - f. Dogs are not permitted on the course with a player if they are playing in the competition.
 - g. **PAYMENT OF FEES** All members' entry fees will be processed through CHIPS (Membership Card) and any member wishing to pay entry fees by credit/debit card or cheque can only do so by paying a minimum of £10, which will be added to membership card, prior to taking entry fee.

PRACTICE

Where more than one competition takes place on the same day, playing in one does not constitute
practising on the course for the other.

HANDICAPS

- Limits: See also Notes on previous page.
 - A <u>Handicap Limit</u> means players of a higher handicap <u>will not</u> be allowed to enter.

 In <u>Individual Stroke Play</u> each player must record his correct *Playing Handicap* on the scorecard (for the purpose of calculating the CSS) and the Committee will adjust the scores for the purpose of awarding prizes.
- Certificates & CDH: <u>Visitors handicap certificates are required</u>. Each competitor, who is not a member of RSD, should produce a current CONGU Handicap Certificate & CDH Number. Penalty for failure to produce verification of current handicap is disqualification.
- 3. In singles match play competition the full handicap difference of the players is to be given.
- 4. Any changes of playing handicap must be notified to the starter. A player whose handicap is controlled by another Club must declare any reduction in handicap that would have resulted from one of the competitions in a Meeting. No similar increases are permitted until the new handicap is posted at the 'Home' Club.
- 5. No handicap changes affect a match play competition which is already in progress.

STARTING TIMES

- Starting Times will be posted in the Clubhouse and on the Club's website prior to the event and may be
 obtained from the Office or Professional Shop. All competitors must check a day before the competition for
 up to date tee times.
- 2. Players must report to the starter at least 5 minutes before they are due to play.

- 3. If the player arrives at his/her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes <u>after</u> his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on the time is loss of the first hole in match play or two strokes in stroke play (Rule 6-3a). Otherwise, the penalty for breach of this Rule is disqualification.
- Starting times noted in the entry book for each competition are a rough guide and may vary dependant on number of entries.

SCRATCHINGS

- 1. Please inform the Office or Pro Shop in good time if you are unable to play at the appointed time.
- 2. Players who consistently fail to turn up to play without notification or adequate reason will be **banned** from two Board competitions.

RULES

- Competitions shall be played in accordance with the current edition of the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited.
- 2. The ball the player plays must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R & A. Penalty for Breach of Condition Disqualification.
- The driver the competitor carries must have a clubhead identified by model and loft that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R & A Rules Limited.
 An updated List is available on the R & A website www.randa.org.
- 4. In 18-hole competitions, ties will be decided over the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes, thereafter the last 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 holes.
- 5. In 36-hole competitions, ties will be decided over the second 18 holes, or, if still a tie, on the best last 9 holes of the day and thereafter as 4. above.

BUGGIES

- 1. Buggies may be used in any stroke-play competition.
- Buggies may be used in match-play competitions by players with a medical condition, who have submitted a
 medical certificate, signed by a doctor to that effect, to the Club Manager. <u>Players, other than those
 authorised to use a buggy, may not use another player's buggy to carry their bag</u>. In match-play, a caddy may
 use a buggy.

SLOW PLAY

- 1. Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay (Rule 6-7 of the Rules of Golf) usually 3 ¼ hours for two ball matches and 3 ¾ hours for three ball matches, subject to weather adjustment.
- 2. Penalties for falling behind these rates are as stated in Rule 6-7.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

- If, during a stipulated round, a player uses distance measuring devices that are designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
 Mobile phone Apps are allowed.
- Since the distance between two objects is information and not advice, such information may be shared between players, subject to the speed of play requirements.

ABANDONED COMPETITIONS

In the event of the competition being abandoned due to extremely adverse weather conditions rendering the course unplayable, a result will only be declared provided all competitors have started and at least ¾ of the scores have been returned.

PRIZE-GIVING

Prize winners are expected to make every effort to attend the Presentations, appropriately dressed.
